The meeting was called to order at 9:30am. A motion was made to approve the January minutes.

**I. Special Guests – Bob Gilbertson from Sonic**

We have a new General Manager (Tim King) coming to the Roxborough Sonic and will be living within Roxborough with his family. The GM will be focusing in bettering the store and hopes to also decrease the complaints that the Sonic store has received. Safety and Crime is also very important to the GM. The Sonic has a fund raising program that they want to offer to the school &/or Hands Across Roxborough which will designate a day each week that a portion of all sales will be donated back to the school or Hands Across Roxborough. The Sonic wants to be a contributor to the Roxborough Community.

**II. Announcements**

**✚ County Updates – Steve Board**

- EEE- Still moving forward, funds have been set aside.
- Rebuild of road will still be occurring on Village Circle Drive East. Start date has not been determined yet; the time frame that the road will be closed will be approx. 3 months.
- The shoulders on Titan Road will be extended even further. This has been a huge help for drivers and bikers. Maintenance of the shoulders needs to be added to the work load as gravel and sand needs to be removed from the shoulders.
- The county is still cutting costs, anticipating future revenue reductions, 2011 will be even tighter. Major staff realignment will continue.
- Fall project for CDOT is moving forward on 4 lanes from Titan Road to Castle Rock. Ramp over Santa Fe to start early 2011.
- Emergency Operation Plan – April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010. All day event involving homes in Roxborough Park, West Metro Fire Department, Sterling Ranch, Primary School and the Intermediate School. The Primary School is the location for the shelter. Communication between Emergency centers is the biggest issue and also the Radio Communication is important. This is a big event and should be a huge learning exercise.
- Lamb Springs – Adding new board members, still working with the Smithsonian and the Denver Nature Science Museum. Lamb Springs is an ongoing topic.



- Medical Marijuana in Douglas County – Deliberation was completed on February 3, 2010. No dispensaries within 2 miles of a high school and no dispensaries within 1 mile of an elementary school. Industrial zone locations are ok. There has been one home in Roxborough that was growing the plants and these renters were evicted from the home.



**Chatfield Reservoir Storage Reallocation** – Larry Moore

- Release date of documentation will be in June.
- Estimated cost is 125 million and Roxborough will be taking part in this cost.
- The EIS is 95% complete.



**Roxborough Schools** – Rick Kendall

- Budget reductions – Douglas County is the moving target.
- 40 million dollar cut = \$200-\$400 per student cut.
- Principal position is open and the Superintendent position is also open.
- Accreditation visit was a huge success.



**Sterling Ranch** – Jack Hoagland

- Planning in a 2012 start date on the development.
- Still working on the water issue.
