The meeting was called to order at 9:30am. A motion was made to approve the October Minutes.

I. Announcements

✚ **Douglas County Libraries**

- The Douglas County Libraries have seen a 15-20% increase in growth.

✚ **County Updates**

- EEE – Douglas County is pleased to announce plans for the construction of a long awaited Emergency Egress Easement that will connect the south end of Roxborough Park Subdivision with the Indian Creek Subdivision. This connection will provide emergency access in the event of a wildfire or other emergency situation and will be gated at both ends to restrict use to emergency access only. The Roxborough Park/ Indian Creek EEE will be constructed in two phases with completion scheduled for fall 2010. Open house to be held on October 13th, 2009 to discuss the plans for the EEE.
- Bike safety program – is in the works, widening of Titan Road has begun, should be completed shortly. The widening of the road will allow more room for the bikers.
- Arrowhead Shores Community Center – neighborhood is 50/50 on the reopening. Meeting will be held on the 14th of October to discuss the mill levy and answer questions that the neighborhood has. Meeting will be held at Roxborough Intermediate.
- Lamb Springs – Continue to develop the plan. SCFD funding. Will be discussing the direction to take within the next 6 months. Local archeologist will be added to the board.



✚ **Chatfield Reservoir Storage Reallocation**

- Ongoing issue. Information can be found at www.chatfieldstudy.org.
 - Reservoir Reallocation – Just returned from Washington. The Corp program and the budget departments did not communicate well. The funding request was not approved, possible funding shortfall for fiscal year 2010. The Colorado congressional delegations are trying to help by making calls to the Corps. Udall, Pearlmuter and DeGette have taken the lead. The EIS is scheduled to be released to the public by February or March 2010.

✚ **Hands Across Roxborough**

- The Bull that Sterling Ranch purchased for Hands Across Roxborough fed 16 families. Many families in need, all donations are appreciated.

✚ **Roxborough Schools**

- Students are riding more bikes to school; we have added more bike racks to accommodate.
- Primary Building – parents are driving their children to school more now than in the past. Another street may be added to create less loop traffic.
- Construction starts this summer on the Primary school.
- Roboratlars – students are solving problems through robots. The students are looking into locating grants for this project.
- School Board election is this year, 4 seats are available. Need to vote, ballots go out October 6th.

✚ **PTIC**

- Rextrot raised \$269.00, Golf Tournament raised \$2500.00. The Fall Family social was very good this year, large attendance. We lost \$145.00, but the event was great.
